(5 & 6 year old boys & girls in Kindergarten)

Recreation baseball is for boys between the ages of 7 - 15 years old. There are 3 leagues available separated by age:

Peanut League - 7 & 8 year old boys Junior League - 9, 10, 11, 12 year old boys

Boys Senior League - 13, 14, 15 year old boys

Softball

Recreation softball is for girls between ages 7 - 15 years old

There are 3 leagues available separated by age:

Pee Wee League - 7, 8, 9 year old girls Pigtail League - 8, 9, 10 year old girls

Ponytail League - 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 year old girls

Suburban Softball - A traveling team for girls in 7th & 8th grade.

Tryouts will be held in March.

Any girl who does not make the team will be automatically placed on a **Ponytail League** team.

Little League

Little League is for boys ages 9-12. Tryouts will be held in February 27th & 28th at the Belleville Middle School. Any boy who does not make a team will be automatically placed on a Junior Rec League team. Applications are available at the Belleville Recreation Department and must be returned to the Recreation Department.

*Little League is managed and operated independently from the Belleville Recreation Department.
