- Have Special guests and Specialized Police Units share their expertise and knowledge;
- Develop the concept of teamwork, self-confidence, and enhanced communication skills in the attendee;
- Conduct both classroom and hands-on training, crime scene analysis, first aid, and physical training;
- ***Friday, June 30<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 pm, formal graduation ceremony for all participants and limited to 4 family members ONLY.***

The program will take place from 9:00 am – 3:30 pm, beginning Monday, June 26<sup>th</sup>, and concluding on Friday, June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023. All participants should arrive at the new Belleville Indoor Training Facility located at 522 Cortlandt Street for a prompt 9:00 am start, with a brown bag lunch and water bottle; please write your name on both. Dismissal will be at 3:30 pm. There will be no supervision available after 3:30 pm, so please make the proper arrangements.

**Class size and graduation may be subject to limitations based upon building code restrictions. Applications should be returned promptly and will be accepted on a first come first serve basis.**
