IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Monitoring Requirements Not Met for Belleville (NJ0701001)

The Township of Belleville continues to adhere to all water testing requirements. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we are did to correct these situations.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During the year 2022 we did not complete all monitoring or testing within specific time periods for disinfection by-products (DBP), i.e., Haloacetic Acid 5 (HAA5) and Total Trihalomethane (TTHM), and, therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

The table below lists the contaminant that we were required to test and the timeframe guidelines.

Analyte	Required sampling frequency or sample period	Number of samples taken	When samples should have been taken	When samples were taken
DBP	Quarterly	4	February 2022	March 2022

What is being done?

The Township will adhere to the monitoring schedule for the remainder of year 2022.
