IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Monitoring Requirements Not Met for Belleville (NJ0701001)

Our water system infringed drinking water requirements over the past several years. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we are did to correct these situations.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During the second half of 2023 we did not complete all monitoring or testing within specific time periods for water quality parameters (WQP), i.e., pH and orthophosphate, and, therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.

The number of required samples were taken during the cited half year time period. However, a small percentage of the samples were not taken during the required bi-weekly schedule, instead, within several days.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

What is being done?

The Township will adhere to the monitoring schedule for the year 2025.
