E-BIKE LAWS

STARTING JULY 19, 2026

ENFORCEMENT BEGINS ON UPDATED E-BIKE REGULATIONS
ACROSS NEW JERSEY.

ALL E-BIKES NOW REQUIRE:

- ✓ A LICENSED RIDER
- ✓ STATE REGISTRATION WITH THE NJ MVC
- ✓ LIABILITY INSURANCE COVERAGE

KEY RIDER REQUIREMENTS



LICENSING

- E-bike riders must:
- Possess a valid New Jersey driver's license OR
- Be at least 15 years old and obtain a motorized bicycle license



REGISTRATION

- All e-bikes must be registered with the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission (MVC)



INSURANCE

- Throttle-assist owners are now required to carry liability insurance coverage, similar to motor vehicles

MINIMUM AGE REQUIREMENT

- Riders under the age of 15 are not permitted to operate e-bikes/motor assistance
