IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER**Monitoring and Reporting Requirements Not Met for Belleville (NJ0701001)**

Our water system violated drinking water requirements over the past year. Even though it is not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct the situation.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether our drinking water meets health standards. During the first half of 2024, the second half of 2024, the first half of 2025, and the second half of 2025 we did not complete all monitoring for our established Water Quality Parameters which are pH and orthophosphate. Therefore, we cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.

The table below lists the contaminants we did not properly monitor and report during the last two years and how often we are supposed to sample.

Analyte	Required sampling frequency
pH	2 Samples every 14 days
Orthophosphate	2 Samples every 14 days

The number of required samples were taken during the cited half year time period. However, a very small percentage of the samples were not taken during the required bi-weekly schedule, instead, within several days.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do.

However, if you have specific health concerns, a severely compromised immune system, have an infant, are pregnant, or are elderly, you may be at higher risk than other individuals and should seek advice from your health care providers about drinking this water.

What is being done?

The Township will adhere to the monitoring schedule for the year 2026.
